



Asclepias tuberosa- Butterfly Milkweed

- Pollinator value- very high
- Bloom time- June to July
- Flower color- orange
- Height- 1 to 2 feet
- Wetland Indicator- FAC
- Light requirements- full sun to part sun
- Habitat- prairies, open woods, roadsides
- Soil moisture- dry, moist
- **Value to Beneficial Insects**- long-tongued bees, Sphecid wasps, and various butterflies, including Swallowtails and Fritillaries Monarch, Grey Hairstreak, Queen, and hummingbirds.
